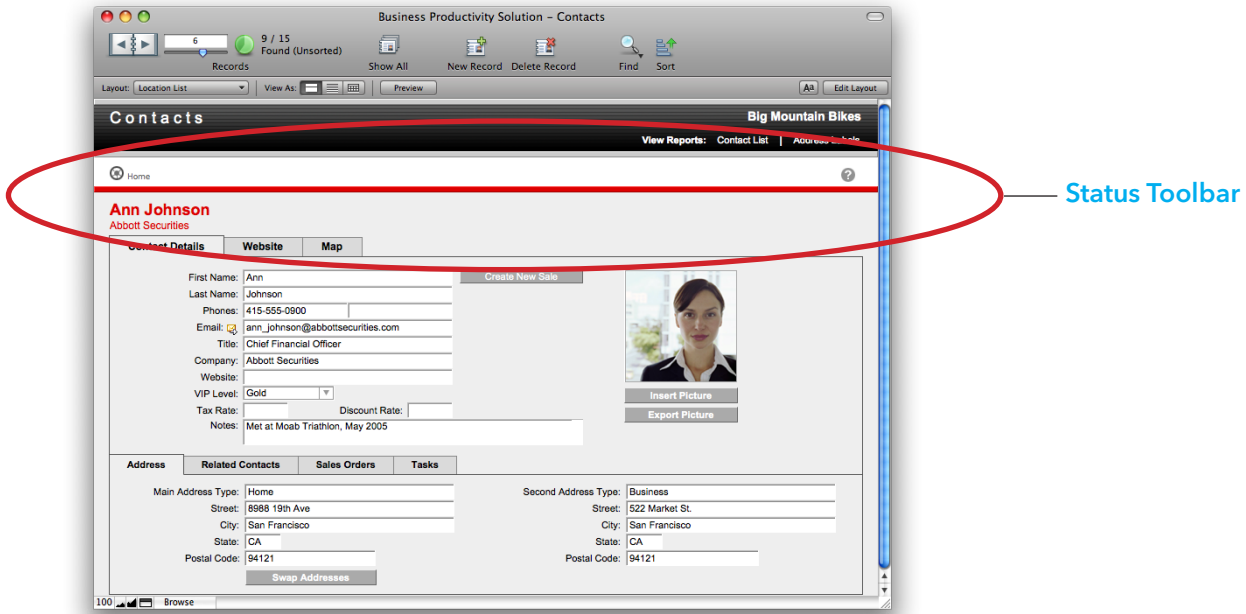
Guide to the new user interface

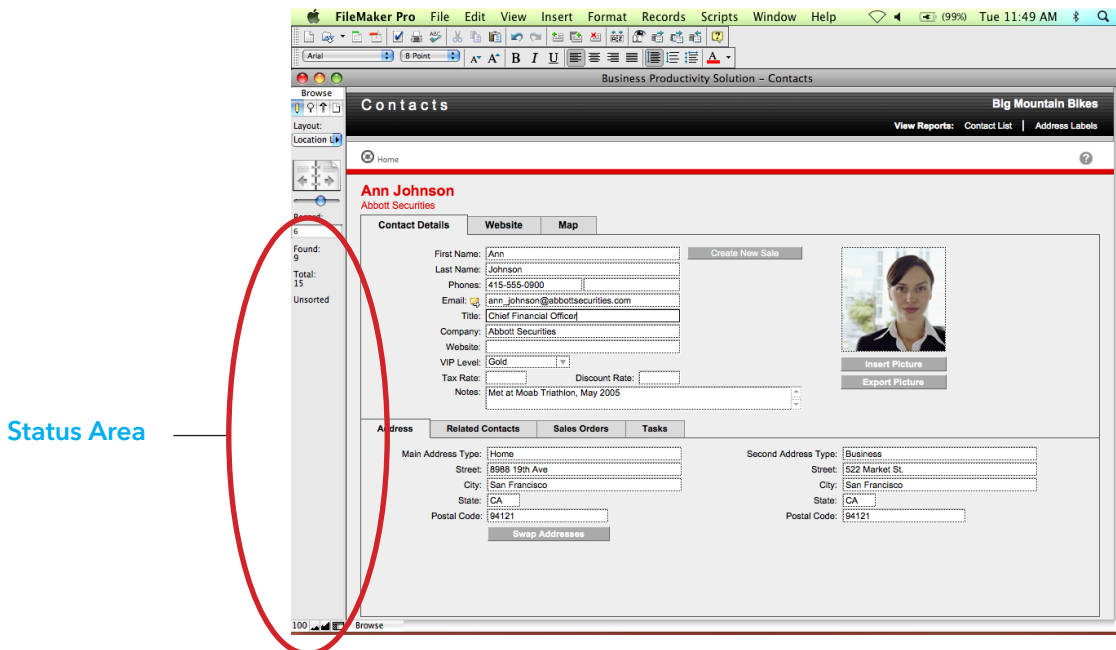
FileMaker Pro 10 - Overview

The new Status Toolbar combines elements from the Status Area and the Standard Toolbar from previous versions of FileMaker Pro for increased visibility and ease of use.

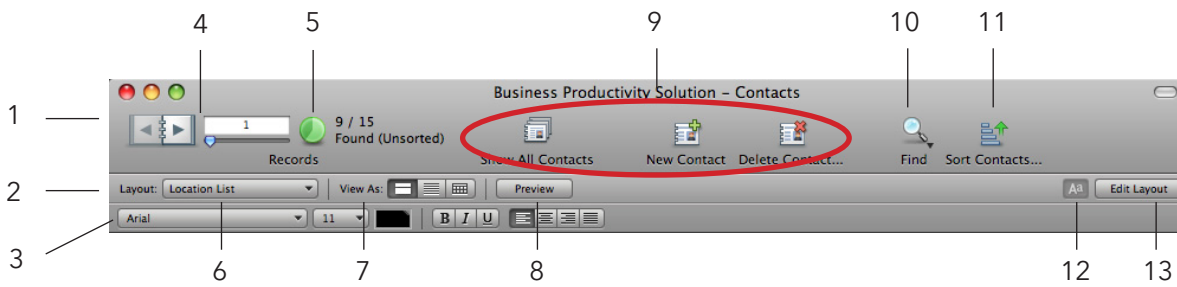


Previous versions of FileMaker Pro - Overview

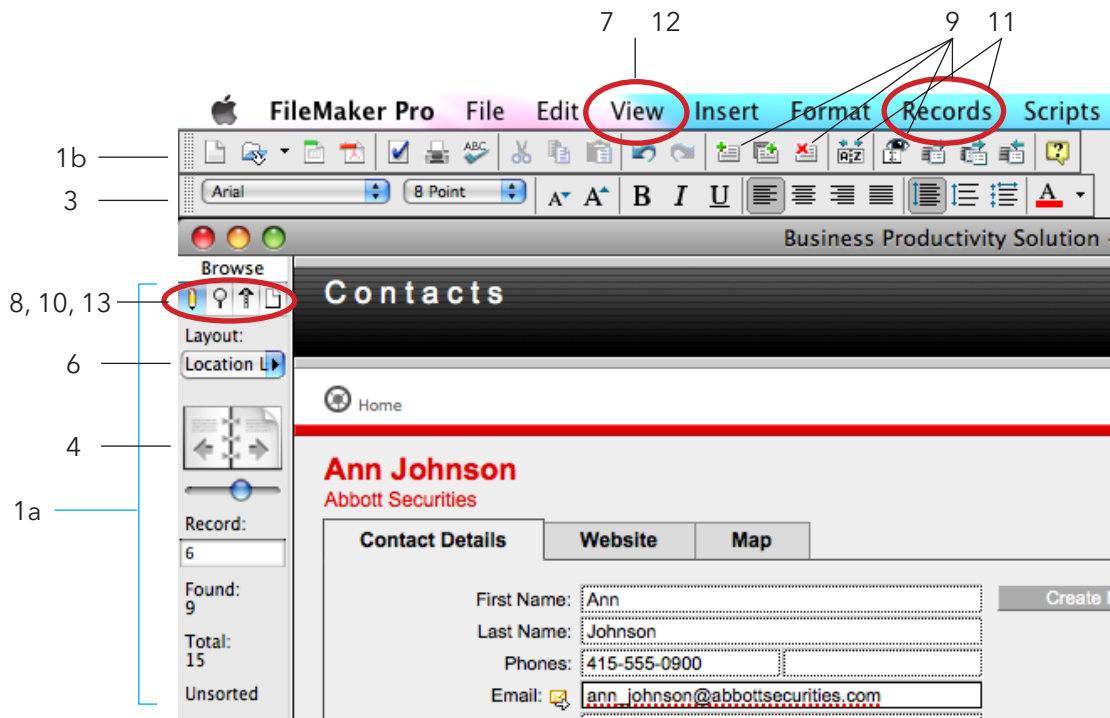
The Status Area was on the left side, and the commands were available as buttons in the Standard Toolbar or as menu items.

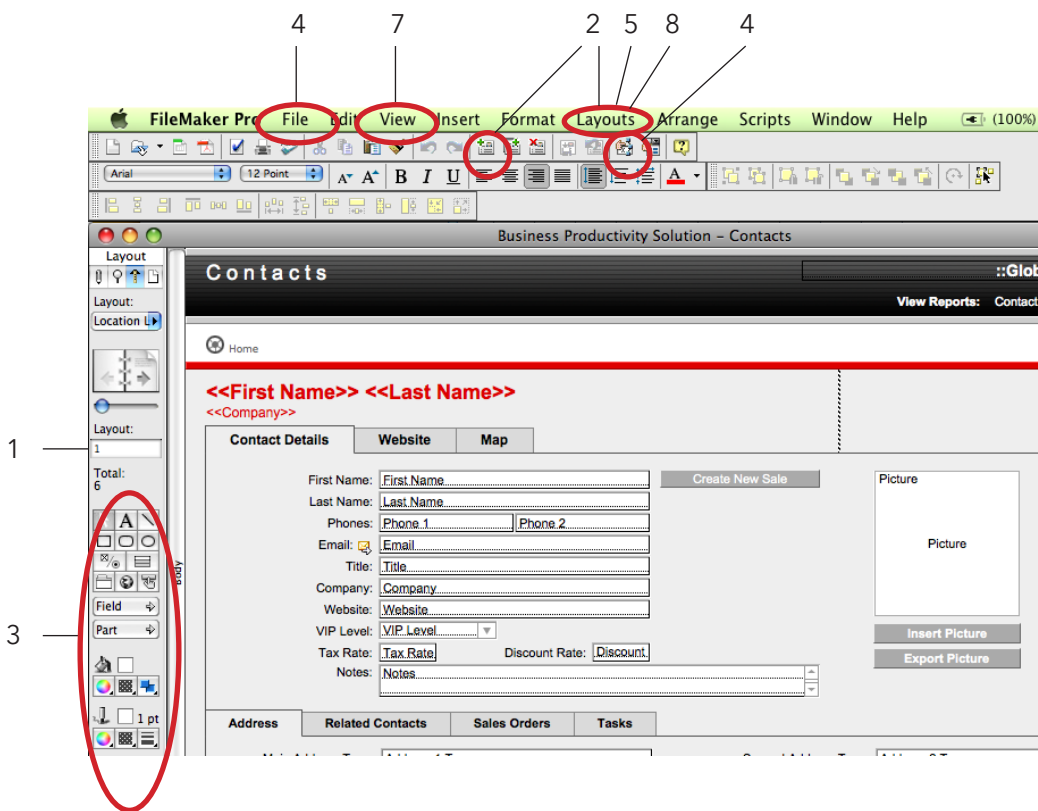
